

Making Mexican Tissue Paper Flowers

Materials Needed:

Coloured sheets of tissue paper
scissors
pipe cleaners

Directions:

1. Layer the coloured sheets of tissue paper.
2. Fold them like an accordion and then fold them in half.
3. Scallop or fringe the tips using scissors.
4. Wind a pipe cleaner around the middle (where the fold is) to secure the paper, and to create a stem.
5. Spread the layers of “petals” out and fluff them out to look like flowers.
